**Isaiah 9:6** “For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

**Psalms 54:4** “Behold, God is my helper; the Lord is the upholder of my life.”
